TAX-DEDUCTIBLE WAYS TO GIVE TO THE *field of dreams*

OUTRIGHT GIFTS

PLEDGE OF CASH, PAYABLE OVER A THREE-YEAR PERIOD. You may pay/charge annually, quarterly or on a payment schedule that best fits your circumstances. Automatic Withdrawal and Scheduled On-line Banking payments are also an option.

MATERIALS/GIFTS-IN-KIND. Under certain conditions it is possible for the Panhandle Parks Foundation to accept gifts that meet with the specific need of the "Field of Dreams" campaign project. The donor may claim as a tax deduction any gift of inventory based on the donor's cost or fair market value, whichever is lower. Examples include building materials, equipment, landscaping, printing, etc.

APPRECIATED PROPERTY. You may have in your possession a home or other real estate or tangible personal property (e.g., motor vehicles, boats, office equipment). These will be reported at the donor's appraised value at the time such gifts are made.

A gift of stocks or bonds. With the current tax laws, this is an extremely popular type of gift. For example, gifts of stock are deductible the same as cash and are valued at the date of the gift. The process is simple and the donor gets the advantage of both the income tax deduction as well as avoiding any capital gains on the subsequent sale of the stock by the Panhandle Parks Foundation.

DEFERRED GIFTS

LIFE INSURANCE. The beneficiary or beneficiaries of your life insurance policy may either be no longer living or no longer in need of the policy proceeds. The Panhandle Parks Foundation may be named as the beneficiary or owner of the policy.

A BEQUEST IN YOUR WILL. While not of immediate benefit to the capital project, the proceeds would help the future operation of the multi-sports complex. A gift may be handled by a codicil to your will.

LIFE INCOME GIFTS

TRUSTS. Trusts can provide for the Panhandle Parks Foundation while the donor receives a steady source of income for themselves. You also can set up what's known as a charitable lead trust, from which a charity receives the income and your heirs the principal; or a charitable remainder trust, in which your heirs get the income and the charity gets the principal. These avoid the capital gains tax.

DIRECT DONATIONS OF AN IRA. IRA owners aged 70 1/2 and older, can donate up to \$100,000 of their IRA's to charity through 2012 without having to report the withdrawal as income and deduct the donation as a charitable contribution. Deductions will not be limited but the Adjusted Gross income cap on charitable contributions or the itemized deduction phase-out. Amounts donated in this way count as all or part of the IRA owner's required minimum distribution.
