

Historically, apples have been used to remedy a variety of ailments - hence the adage "an apple a day keeps the doctor away."

doctor away." Modern research reveals the healthy attributes of the phytonutrients in apples. Apples contain a variety of phytochemicals, including quercetin, catechin, phloridzin and chlorogenic acid, all of which are strong antioxidants. Apples have as much

antioxidant activity as 1,500 mg of vitamin C (20 times the recommended daily intake for women). Malic and tartaric acids inhibit the growth of disease promoting bacteria in the digestive tract.

Compounds found in apples can lower LDL cholesterol levels and protect against atherosclerosis. Pectin, a soluble fiber found in the skin, lowers cholesterol and blood glucose levels, and also can bind and remove toxic metals (such as lead and mercury). Eating apples has been consistently linked with reduced risks of lung, breast, colon and digestive cancers, heart disease, asthma, and type 2 diabetes. They have been found to



aid respiratory health and even help women lose weight. A 2003 Brazilian study showed that eating three apples a day for 12 weeks helped participants lower their blood-glucose levels and lose an average of 2.7 pounds.

## Fair Trade Spotlight Ganesh Himal Trading



When Spokane-based Ganesh Himal Trading began choosing their partners in Nepal 27 years ago, there was no "Fair Trade Federation" or "Fair Trade criteria." They knew what they perceived as fair working partnerships, and, as the movement grew, they were thrilled to see that their model fit within the guidelines of what others also perceived as fair.

Today, Spokane-based Ganesh Himal supplies North American shops and retail customers with high quality, handcrafted clothing, jewelry, textiles and paper. As the only step between producers and stores, they import from small cottage industries in Nepal.

Their goal has always been to support work that enhances people's lives and traditions. One example is the story of Laxmi.

Laxmi is a traditional weaver in Nepal who did not receive an education as a child. Due to her husband's insufficient income, they were also unable to provide schooling for their three children. Over 20 years ago, Laxmi approached the Association for Craft Producers (ACP), a group that Ganesh Himal works with, and asked them to help her earn money with her weaving. They helped her get started, and she was able to send her children to school. Her daughter, Sudha, received a Masters in Social Work from Tribhuvan University and became the first educated woman in the family. Today, Laxmi has a weaving group of over 60 women, overseen by Sudha. They make a good income and the village men have started working for them as well!

This is the type of cultural change that Ganesh Himal sees as long lasting and sustainable, and one that they strive to promote. Because of this desire, they are members of the Fair Trade Federation, an organization dedicated to promoting respect and fair interaction, at all levels, between producers and consumers. They are also part of the Green America Business Network and co-founders, with Sita Gurung, of the Baseri Health Clinic in Baseri, Nepal.

Ganesh Himal products are high quality and affordable. To keep expenses low and pass on affordability to the consumer, Ganesh Himal owns its own warehouse and promotes environmental sustainability. One example is a line of bags made from recycled rubber inner tube tires, created to keep a Nepalese junkyard from burning the tires and creating air pollution. # NON GMO Project



#### GMO FAQs\*

October 2011 marks the second ever Non-GMO Month. This year, Pilgrim's Market continues its involvement in educating our customers so that all of us can make informed decisions about our health and our food.

#### WHAT ARE GMOS?

GMOs ("genetically modified organisms") are organisms that have been created through the gene splicing techniques of biotechnoloty (also called genetic engineering, or GE). This relatively new science merges DNA from different species, creating combinations of plant, animal, bacteria and viral genes that cannot occur in nature or in traditional crossbreeding.

Virtually all commerciall GMOs are bred to withstand direct application of herbicide and/or to produce an

insecticide. Despite biotech industry promises, none of the GMO traits currently on the market offer increased yield, drought tolerance, enhanced nutrition or any other consumer benefit. Meanwhile, a growing body of evidence connects GMOs with health problems, environmental damage and violation of farmers' and consumers' rights.

#### Are GMOs Safe to Eat?

In 30 countries around the world, including Australia, Janapan and all the countries in the European Union, there are significant restrictions or outright bans on the production of GMOs, because they are not considered proven safe. In the U.S., on the other hand, the government has approved commercial production of GMOs based on studies conducted by the companies who created them and profit from their sale.

#### What Foods Might Be GMO?

The following crops carry risk of being genetically modified, because GMO varieties are commercially produced in North America and certain other parts of the world or because there are known instances of contamination.

Alfalfa, Flax, Sugar Beets, Canola, Papaya Zucchini, Corn, Rice, Yellow Summer Squash, Cotton Soy.

Animal derivatives such as milk, meat and eggs are also considered high-risk, because of potential GMO contamination in feed.

#### Are GMOs Labeled?

Many health-conscious shoppers find the results of rigorous, independent, scientific examination on the impact of consuming GM foods to be cause for concern. Unfortunately, even though polls consistently show that a significant majority of Americans would like to be able tot tell if the food they're purchasing contains GMOs, the federal government has chosen not to require that companies disclose this information. In the absence of mandatory labeling, the non-GMO Project was created to give consumers the informed choice they deserve.

#### How Can I Avoid GMOs?
